Official Contest Rules

1. BANKROLL

This is a 'live money' handicapping event. Players will be required to deposit \$250 into a contest account, which \$200 will be the players bankroll for event wagering. At the conclusion of the event, any remaining dollar amount in the bankroll is the property of the player.

2. TO ENTER

Fill out the entry form and provide cash payment of \$250 per entry. There is a limit of four (4) entries per player. Entries will close at 4:30p on Saturday, April 13, 2019. Winners/Sportech will not accept checks as a form of payment.

3. FORMAT

This event will include ALL LIVE RACES on Saturday, April 13th originating from Aqueduct, Keeneland & Gulfstream Park. The event will conclude after all originating matinee track races are official for Saturday, April 13, 2019.

Wager types permitted are: Win, Place, Show, Exacta and Trifecta.

- Players will wager from a contest card in venue or through a special one day telephone betting account.
- Minimum wager amount(s) is defined by the track; there are no maximums – players may wager as much as they have; including winnings from their bankroll, whenever they wish.
- To be eligible for prize pool payout, players must wager a minimum of \$200 per account.
- The player with the highest bankroll after all qualifying races are official on Saturday,

April 13th will be declared the winner.

- It is the players' responsibility to meet the wagering requirements listed above.
- Winners Tournament Officials will make all decisions on disqualification. In the event of a rule violation all decisions by the Winners Tournament Officials are final.
- Any remaining bankroll on the players wagering card remains the property of the player.

4. PRIZES

This event has a \$7,500 guaranteed prize pool. In the event of a tie, prize money for those positions will be equality divided among the players involved.

5. CONTEST CARDS AND SPECIAL ONE DAY ACCOUNTS

Each player will be issued a contest card or have a special one day contest account to use to place event wagers. The contest card or special one day contest account will contain the 'real money' bankroll of \$200 per account. If a player loses their card or the card is not working, the player should immediately contact a contest official to receive a new card. Winners/ Sportech are not responsible for "shut-outs," incomplete transactions or mechanical failure of any Tote machine used for event wagering. Furthermore, Winners/ Sportech and Mywinners.com are not responsible for Venue loss of power, communication or other acts of god. No exceptions under any circumstances.

6. PLACING WAGERS

All contest wagers must be made on self-service wagering terminals (SST's) using your contest card and pin number. Telephone wagering players will use the Telephone Betting service operators or Winners IVR system to place event wagers. Players must place all wagers personally. No person shall directly or indirectly act as an intermediary, transmitter, or agent in placing wagers for the player, unless authorized by Winners/ Sportech Tournament Officials. All official track rulings will apply to wagers placed in the event except if otherwise stipulated. The event will be based on the official placement and matinee parimutuel prices from the designated contest tracks as defined by Winners/ Sportech. If a player wagers on a track other than an eligible event track or race for purposes of the Big Money Saturday event that player will be sanctioned, up to and including disqualification. All wagers should be placed early to avoid being shut-out.

7. CASHING OUT

Players should not cash out their contest card or one day account until the Big Money Saturday event on Saturday, April 13, 2019 becomes official. Should the player cash out their card or account before the event is official; that player can be disqualified from any prize pool consideration.

8. IRS WITHOLDING

Event winners are subject to all state and federal tax requirements. In the case of an IRS ticket(s), withholding will automatically be deducted from the players contest card or one day account. The player will need to see or contact a Winners manager or Customer Care representative to complete tax information before the funds are released, for contest scoring purposes, the gross amount of the winning wager will be recorded as the players score. Please note for purposes of Big Money Saturday event wagering; only the net amount (the amount received after the IRS withholding) will be available to the player to wager.

9. SCRATCHES

If a horse (runner) is scratched after a wager is placed, the players may cancel the wager. In certain instances the player must wait for the race to become official before they are credited back the amount placed on their selected runner(s).

10. TIES

In the event of a tie, prize money for those positions will be equality divided among the contestants involved.

11. CONTEST LEADERBOARD

Current standings will be posted after every race or as soon as the information becomes available. Standings will be posted on a dedicated URL link:

Note: It may take from 2 to 5 minutes for the leaderboard to update after official race results are in.

12. INELIGIBILITY/DISCLOSURE

Officers and employees of Sportech/ Winners working as contest operations staff, mutual tellers, Tote, telephone betting operators and telephone betting customer service representatives, and their immediate families, and employees of the Department of Consumer Protection – Gaming Division, State of Connecticut, and their immediate families, are not eligible to enter the contest.

The right is reserved to terminate, withdraw or modify this contest at any time without prior notice. In the event that the contest does not happen, remaining account fees and prize pool entry contributions will be refunded.

15. TAXES

Liabilities for any and all federal, state and local taxes are solely the responsibility of prize winners.

16. AFFIDAVITS

Affidavits confirming compliance of all the rules of this contest will be required of all participants. All prize winners acknowledge that if they enter this event under a fraudulent name and/or Social Security number, they will be immediately disqualified from the event. Positive identification is required of contestants and prize winners. Positive identification is a Driver License with a picture and corroborating address and birth date used on the entry form, and/or other forms of identification as deemed adequate by event officials. Player's also consent to the use of their names, pictures and video images by Winners/ Sportech.

17. JUDGING AND DISPUTES

The management of Winners/ Sportech reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to this event, without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. All decisions made by Winners/ Sportech Tournament Officials will be final and all questions and definitions not covered explicitly in these rules shall be interpreted by Tournament officials. Winners/ Sportech reserve the right to amend these rules at any time.
